A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY CLASSES

PURSUANT TO the *Property Assessment and Taxation Act* of the Northwest Territories, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, Chapter P-10 as amended;

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Inuvik deems it desirable and necessary to establish property classes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. The following classes of property are established in the municipality of Inuvik:

THE IOI	lowing classes of	property are established in the municipality of inuvik;		
(A)	Class 1	Commercial – comprised of: Property principally used for the sale of goods or services		
(B)	Class 2	Undeveloped Commercial – comprised of: Vacant land zoned for commercial purposes		
(C)	Class 3	Industrial – comprised of: Property principally used for manufacturing, processing or other industrial purposes		
(D)	Class 4	Undeveloped Industrial – comprised of: Property principally zoned for industrial purposes		
(E)	Class 5	Residential – comprised of: (i) Property principally used for residential purposes (ii) Property that is not described in any other property class		
(F)	Class 6	Undeveloped Residential – comprised of: (i) Property that is vacant land and not zoned for commercial, industrial, institutional or recreational purposes		
(G)	Class 7	Recreational – comprised of: (i) Property operated on a non-profit basis principally used for recreational purposes (ii) Vacant land zoned for recreational purposes		
(H)	Class 8	Institutional – comprised of: (i) Property operated by a non-profit organization or used for such purposes as a health facility, school, fire hall, or police detachment (ii) vacant land zoned for institutional purposes
