ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

1. The Town of Inuvik takes pride in its community facilities and wishes to allow the public to use and enjoy those facilities in a safe and harassment free environment.

For that reason, the Town has adopted a Zero Tolerance Policy at all of our community facilities with respect to inappropriate public behaviour. The Policy is designed to ensure that all the residents of our community are able to enjoy their facilities without fear of harassment, abuse or disruptive behaviour.

All members of the public who use the Town's facilities are expected to respect the rights of others who use the facilities, and not to engage in behaviour that prevents others from enjoying them. The Town reserves the right to prohibit those who engage in certain kinds of disruptive behaviour from using any of the Town's facilities.

Accordingly, persons who engage in such behaviour will be prohibited from using any of the Town's facilities for a period of time as determined by the Town. Those who are prohibited from using the Town's facilities will be removed from the premises, advised in writing of the prohibition, and have their names posted at the facilities for the duration of the prohibition. Persons who return to the Town's facilities while prohibited from using them will be subject to a further prohibition, or if necessary the authorities will be contacted.

Types of behaviour that will result in a person being prohibited from using any Town facility include, but are not limited to:

- behaviour that is:
 - ❖ destructive or unruly
 - ❖ aggressive
 - ❖ threatening
 - ❖ harassing
- yelling, shouting or using language which is:
 - ❖ rude or offensive
 - ❖ profane
 - ❖ abusive

This Policy applies to all members of the public using the Town's facilities, including the Inuvik Family Centre, the Midnight Sun Recreation Complex (including the Community Hall and Curling Rink), the Inuvik Centennial Library and the Inuvik Fire Department.
