# General Information

## SUMMARY

The Arctic Market runs every Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in Jim Koe Park from June 16 to September 15, rain or shine under the big white tent. This is a local market that promotes local growers, artisans, crafters and bakers by providing a community retail venue for their products. While this market is facilitated by the Town of Inuvik, it is supported and led by community volunteers and ideals.

## HOW TO REGISTER

Any local grower, artisan, crafter or baker may register to be a vendor by completing a registration form and returning it to [tourism@inuvik.ca](mailto:tourism@inuvik.ca). Registration forms are available at the Town Office, on the Town website or by phoning **(867) 777-8618**. Registration is first come, first served. If space permits, registrations will be accepted on Saturdays at the market.

### **Note: All food vendors require a temporary food permit.**

## WHO IS ABLE TO PARTICIPATE?

If your item is grown, made, carved, sewn, cooked, baked or created by you or by a local community member then this market is for you. Food related items that are acceptable for sale include locally grown vegetables and flowers and hand-made baked goods including jams, cookies, pies, cakes, buns, etc. Craft or artisan items that are acceptable include beaded or sewn items, carvings, crafts, and handmade jewelry or clothing such as scarves, mitts, toques, slippers and kamiks.

## WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED

Store bought food, mass produced or store bought items, household items, used clothing, raffles, lotteries or 50-50 draws.

## COST

\$5.00 per table or \$50.00 per season.

*Volunteers are always welcome.*

## WHAT IS PROVIDED?

The Town of Inuvik will provide one (1) 8' table and two (2) chairs per vendor for up to fifteen (15) vendors per week. These tables will be provided on a first come, first served basis based on registrations received.

## WHAT IS NOT PROVIDED?

*(but we suggest you bring):*

- Table coverings
- Cash boxes/floats
- Necessary health permits for food vendors
- Snacks or water
- Individual booth signage
