

Arctic Market: 10 Things to Know Before You Go



1 WEAR A MASK

All persons entering Town of Inuvik facilities including the Arctic Market are required to wear a mask.



6 LOOK, ADMIRE & BUY... BUT PLEASE DON'T TOUCH

Please do not touch, try on, or handle any items on the crafters tables.



2 BRING CASH

There will be no access to an ATM, so please plan ahead and bring cash.



7 NO ACCESS TO PUBLIC WASHROOMS

Emergency requests will be considered, but please plan ahead as access to public washrooms is not available.



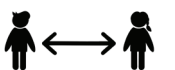
3 LIMIT YOUR GROUP SIZE

It is recommended that only one or two people from each household attend the Arctic Market. We suggest leaving the little ones at home where possible.



8 MAINTAIN 6 FT PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Please do not gather or congregate at entry or exits or within the Community Hall. We ask you make your purchases swiftly and proceed to the exit to allow for other persons to enter.



4 BE PREPARED

Be prepared to give your name, phone number, and answer a few health screening questions upon entry.



9 PRACTICE SAFE HAND HYGIENE

Apply hand sanitizer upon your entry and exit to the Arctic Market.



5 ENTRY & EXIT IS THROUGH THE BACK OF THE COMMUNITY HALL OF THE MIDNIGHT SUN COMPLEX

Please follow all signage, protocols, and procedures provided by Market staff including our need to enforce a strict capacity limits at all times.

Entry Procedures for December 19 Market



RESTRICTIONS

As there are significant limitations and restrictions in place in order to support the health and safety of all participating in the Arctic Market we have had to make some adjustments and considerations for how many people are able to enter the Market at a time.

CAPACITY

Staff will be monitoring the entry door and allowing persons to enter based on a total maximum capacity not to exceed 40 persons inside the Community Hall at any one time.

WAITING

We will have a small **OUTDOOR** waiting area (4 chairs spaced 6 feet apart) just outside the Fitness Centre doors of the Midnight Complex at the rear of the Community Hall.

ARRIVING

Our staff will be monitoring the door at all times and hope to manage the flow of persons inside the Market so that patrons are not required to wait outside for any significant length of time. We have set out precautions for all of our patrons arriving by car, on foot and by taxi.

BY CAR

IF YOU ARE DRIVING please remain in your vehicle until you see a space is available or signaled by Market staff to enter.

ON FOOT

IF YOU ARE WALKING please dress warm and be prepared to wait outside if required prior to entry.

BY TAXI

IF YOU ARE ARRIVING BY TAXI please dress warm and be prepared to wait outside if required prior to entry.

ELDERS

We are also aware that Elders, those with mobility issues, and others may arrive and may require "preferred" entry over others that may also be waiting.

THANK YOU

We sincerely appreciate your patience and understanding as our staff does our best to move persons into and through the Market as quickly as possible while still allowing for ample time to complete their pre-holiday shopping but also in a manner that does not require lengthy wait times for those in line to enter.
