# WHAT'S PROVIDED?

Box of ingredients will be provided to each participant and will contain:

Flour, Salt, Baking Powder, Butter, Jam, Margarine, Oil, Crisco, Plastic Knives, Napkins, Papertowels, Sugar, Eggs, Foil, 2 Silver Trays, Rubber Gloves, & 1 Pair of Tongs

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All contestants will be notified and announced on September 3.

All contestants must apply for and obtain an approved Food Establishment Permit from the Environmental Health Officer of the Government of the Northwest Territories no later than the week of August 30. Contestants will not be able to participate without providing a copy of an approved permit by September 3.

### **HOW DOES THE JUDGING WORK?**

Voting is People's Choice. People are able to purchase a Bannock Ballot for \$5 which allows a sample of each of the Bannock. All proceeds will go to the Inuvik Food Bank.

Ballots are Anonymous. Each entry will be clearly numbered. Upon tasting and deciding their favourite bannock, voters will drop their ballot in the designated ballot box placed in front of their choice of entry At 5pm all ballots will be counted by Town of Inuvik Staff who will then announce the winners and award the prizes.
