

Summer Arctic Market Food Vendors

ATTENTION: All Arctic Market Food Vendors

The Town of Inuvik requires that all vendors that would like to sell food at the Arctic Market to attain a TEMPORARY FOOD ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT. All food vendors are responsible for demonstrating approval by the Environmental Health Officer prior to selling at the Arctic Market.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ARCTIC MARKET

1. All vendors must be approved by the Arctic Market facilitators before selling at any Arctic Market.
2. Baked Goods: Items need to be protected from contaminants. Package these items in plastic wrap or place them in a covered display container. Use serving tongs or other utensils to handle unwrapped items.
3. All other foods: Vendors must contact Environmental Health and obtain approval. Permits must be maintained every week and displayed at the vendor's booth/table.
4. Food vendors that arrive on site without a permit will not be allowed to sell.

The Arctic Market is committed to providing a relatively barrier-free and profitable market experience to all of our vendors. We are also committed to ensuring a safe and pleasurable market experience to all residents and visitors to the Town of Inuvik. We appreciate your understanding and assistance to ensure the Arctic Market continues to be a valuable asset to the community.
