A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO APPOINT A DIRECTOR OF PROTECTIVE SERVICES FOR THE TOWN AND TO SET FORTH CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 42, subsection (1), parts (a) and (b) of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, S.N.W.T. 2003, Chapter 22 and subsequent amendments thereto which state:

- **42.** (1) Council may, by bylaw, appoint officers in addition to the senior administrative officer, and may authorize them to perform
 - (a) any duty or power assigned to the senior administrative officer by this Act, other than those referred to in subsection 45(1); or
 - (b) any other duties the council considers necessary or advisable.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik deems is appropriate and necessary to appoint a Director of Protective Services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. That Mr. James Sawkins is hereby appointed Director of Protective Services for the Town of Inuvik effective October 17, 2011.
- 2. The Director of Protective Services shall report directly to the Senior Administrative Officer.
- 3. The Director of Protective Services shall be paid an annual salary and benefits as established in the Offer of Employment dated September 19, 2011.
- Any previous by-laws dealing with the appointment of a Director of Protective Services or Fire Chief are hereby repealed upon the date of final reading of this bylaw.
- 5. By-law #1461/APP/96 is hereby repealed.
- 6. This by-law will come into effect upon the day of its final passage.
