

**TOWN OF INUVIK
BY-LAW #2607/APP/17**

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO APPOINT A MUNICIPAL BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND TO REGULATE AND DEFINE HIS DUTIES

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 42 of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, S.N.W.T. 2003, c. 22 and subsequent amendments thereto:

42. (1) Council may, by bylaw, appoint officers in addition to the senior administrative officer, and may authorize them to perform
- (a) any duty or power assigned to the senior administrative officer by this Act, other than those referred to in subsection 45(1); or
 - (b) any other duties council considers necessary or advisable.

AND WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik that a By-law Enforcement Officer be appointed to enforce the by-laws of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, with the Council of the Corporation regulating and defining the duties and powers of the said By-law Enforcement Officer and providing for his identification;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This by-law may be cited as the "By-law Enforcement Officer By-law."

DEFINITIONS

2. In this by-law:
- (a) "**Council**" means the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik in the Northwest Territories.
 - (b) "**Town**" means the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik in the Northwest Territories.
 - (c) "**Constable**" means a By-law Enforcement Officer appointed under this by-law.
 - (d) "**Senior Administrative Officer**" means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Town of Inuvik.
 - (e) "**Mayor**" means the elected Mayor of the Town of Inuvik.

BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

3. Timothy Moore is hereby appointed to the position of By-law Enforcement Officer.

DUTIES

4. The By-law Enforcement Officer, under the direction of the Director of Protective Services, shall:
- (a) conduct patrols, investigations and inquiries on behalf of the Town; shall give a written report to the Mayor and Council on a regular basis; and shall appear before Council when requested.


- (b) encourage and ensure the due observance of the provisions of Town by-laws and generally assist the officers of the Town in the administration of such provisions.
- (c) perform such other related duties as designated by the Mayor, Council and Senior Administrative Officer.

OATH

5. Before assuming the duties of his office, the By-law Enforcement Officer shall subscribe and affirm or swear an oath as follows:

I, Timothy Moore , do solemnly and conscientiously promise and swear that I shall, without fear, favour or partiality, and in good conscience, with all loyalty to the Town of Inuvik, discharge with all diligence and discretion, the functions and duties pertaining to the office of By-law Enforcement Officer and in all matters and at all times to conduct myself in a proper and lawful manner.

IDENTIFICATION

- 6. (a) The Senior Administrative Officer shall cause a suitable warrant of identity to be issued to the person for the tenure of his office as By-law Enforcement Officer under the by-law.
- (b) A warrant of identity shall state the name of the person entitled thereto, his title, weight, hair colour, eye colour and the date of his appointment under this by-law.
- (c) The By-law Enforcement Officer shall, at all times, have available on his person the warrant of identity issued to her under this by-law and shall produce it to any person in the course of his duties, upon reasonable request, for inspection.
- (d) A warrant of identification issued under this by-law remains the property of the Town and shall be surrendered to the Senior Administrative Officer upon termination of the office of By-law Enforcement Officer.

REPEALS

8. By-law 2545/APP/13 is hereby repealed.

COMING INTO FORCE

9. This by-law shall take force and effect upon its final passage.
