



## Development Appeal Board Member (DAB)

### **Mission:**

- The Development Appeal Board purpose is to hear those appeals as required by the *Community Planning and Development Act* of the Northwest Territories from persons affected by a decision of the development officer.

### **Goals:**

- To act as a Quasi-Judicial Board and conduct impartial, fair and timely hearings.

### **Structure:**

- The Board shall consist of a Chairperson, a member from City Council and at least three (3) members from the general public.

### **Meeting times:**

- Hearings are held on a as required basis and must be held within (30) days of the receipt of an appeal

### **Appointment term:**

- Appointed concurrently for Three-Year (3) terms by resolution of Council

### **Ineligibility:**

- Employees of the Town of Inuvik cannot be Members

### **Member qualifications:**

- A keen interest in development within the Town of Inuvik;
- Ability to assess information and make objective decisions;
- Ability to provide rational solutions to complex problems;
- Have a general knowledge of the Town;
- Understand the Town's Zoning Bylaw and the Community Planning and Development Act;
- The ability to commit the required time on a year round basis;
- The ability to speak in public and communicate effectively with parties to the appeal;
- Must sign and abide by the Code of Conduct
