



Community Notice FIREWORKS PERMIT

Please be advised that Fireworks are regulated in the Northwest Territories by the Fire Works Regulations of the Fire Prevention Act. Any person who wishes to sell, offer for sale, give, purchase, possess, store or set off fireworks shall apply to the Fire Marshal for written authorization.

This form must be used with every application and distributors are forbidden to sell fireworks to any person not bearing a properly filled out and approved application.

It is necessary to receive permission from the town or community in which the fireworks are being displayed. This means that if someone is coming from another community to purchase fireworks in Inuvik, they will need to have the permit approved in that community. (Get it signed before they come and buy the fireworks here).

The Fire Marshal has designated local assistants to the fire marshal within the local communities with the authority to approve the applications.

In Inuvik, if you want to buy fireworks, follow these directions:

1. Complete the application form. They can be accessed at the following locations:

 - the fire hall
2. Once complete, bring the permit to the fire hall so it can be approved.
 - Call ahead to ensure someone is available to sign the permit.
3. Bring the permit with you to purchase the fireworks.
