

TOWN OF INUVIK
BY-LAW #2006/GEN/02

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO REPEAL A NUMBER OF BY-LAWS WHICH NO LONGER HAVE ANY FORCE OR EFFECT

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 65, subsections (1) and (2) of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act of the Northwest Territories, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c. C-8, and subsequent amendments thereto, which state:

65. (1) Subject to this Act, a council may, by by-law, amend or repeal a by-law.
- (2) The power of a council to amend or repeal a by-law is subject to the same conditions as the power to make the by-law.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik deems it desirable and necessary to repeal by-laws which no longer have any force or effect;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the following borrowing and debenture by-laws are hereby repealed:
