**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO APPOINT A PUBLIC SERVICES DIRECTOR FOR THE TOWN AND TO SET FORTH CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to Section 42 subsection (1), parts (a) and (b) of the Cities, Towns, and Villages Act S.N.W.T. 2003, Chapter 22 which states:

42. (1) Council may, by bylaw, appoint officers in addition to the senior administrative officer, and may authorize them to perform
- (a) any duty or power assigned to the senior administrative officer by this Act, other than those referred to in subsection 45(l); or
  - (b) any other duties council considers necessary or advisable.

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it appropriate and necessary to appoint under the direction of the Senior Administrative Officer a Director of Public Services who will oversee and administer the Town of Inuvik Public Services Department;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik in the Northwest Territories in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1) That Mr. Richard Campbell is hereby appointed Director of Public Services for the Town of Inuvik, effective January 1, 2005.
- 2) The Director of Public Services shall perform his duties as laid out in his Job Description, in addition to performing such other duties as may be required by by-law, or by council resolution.
- 3) The Director of Public Services' Job Description may be subject to change from time to time in order to meet changing political, economic and organizational conditions.
- 4) The Director of Public Services shall report directly to the Senior Administrative Officer.
- 5) The Director of Public Services and Town Engineer shall be paid an annual salary and benefits as established in the Offer of Employment letter dated November 1, 2004, and as laid out in the Town of Inuvik's Personnel Directive Schedule "A" By-law #1987/PERS/02 which may be amended from time to time.
- 6) By-law #1855/APP/00 is hereby repealed.
- 7) This by-law will come into effect upon the day of its final passage.
