

**TOWN OF INUVIK
BY-LAW #2599/GEN/16**

**A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE
NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO REPEAL BY-LAWS WHICH NO LONGER HAVE ANY
FORCE OR EFFECT**

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 73, subsections (1) and (2) of the Cities, Towns and Villages Act of the Northwest Territories, S.N.W.T. 2003, c. C-22, and subsequent amendments thereto, which state:

73. (1) Council may, by by-law, amend or repeal a by-law.
- (2) The power of a council to amend or repeal a by-law is subject to the same conditions as the power to make the by-law.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik deems it desirable and necessary to repeal by-laws which no longer have any force or effect;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, in Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the following Recreation by-laws are hereby repealed:
