

BY-LAW 275

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF INUVIK IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO CLOSE A CERTAIN HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS pursuant to the municipal ordinance by-laws may be passed provided for the closing of highways,

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to provide additional land for expansion of the Town Works Department,

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 151 of the said Ordinance a Notice of By-Law, a copy of which notice is hereby appended as Schedule A, was published on four consecutive Thursdays in The Drum and was posted up on the 13th day of November, 1974, in each of six public places in the Town of Inuvik,

AND WHEREAS on the advertised day of January 8th, 1975, at 7:30 P.M., the Council of the Town of Inuvik being duly assembled to hear in person or of any person who claims that his land will be prejudiciously or injuriously affected by this by-law, no such person or agent applied to be heard,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Inuvik, in session duly assembled, enacts as follows;

1. All that portion of the road allowance in Block 15 in the Town of Inuvik in the Northwest Territories, according to a plan of survey filed in the Land Titles Office under Number 228, said portion being the same that is shown on the sketch in said Schedule A which shall be a part of the By-law said portion being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the north-east corner of Lot 5, thence westerly feet, more or less, along the northerly boundaries of Lots 5, 6, and 7 the north-west corner of said lot 7, then north-easterly 120 feet, more or less along the most easterly boundary of said road allowance, thence easterly, 112 feet, more or less, along the most southerly boundary of Lot 3 - a point on said road allowance, thence southerly 137 feet, more or less across said road allowance to the starting point is hereby closed.

2. The Mayor and Secretary-Manager are hereby authorized, upon the commission into effect of this by-law, on behalf of the Town of Inuvik to purchase land within the aforesaid portion of road allowance being closed for a reasonable sum from the Government of the Northwest Territories, plus the cost of surveying the said land.


3. And further, upon conveyance of the said land to the Town of Inuvik Mayor and Secretary-Manager are hereby authorized to retain the land for the purpose of expanding the Town Works Department facilities.

4. This by-law shall come into effect upon the approval of the Commission and the final day of passing thereof.

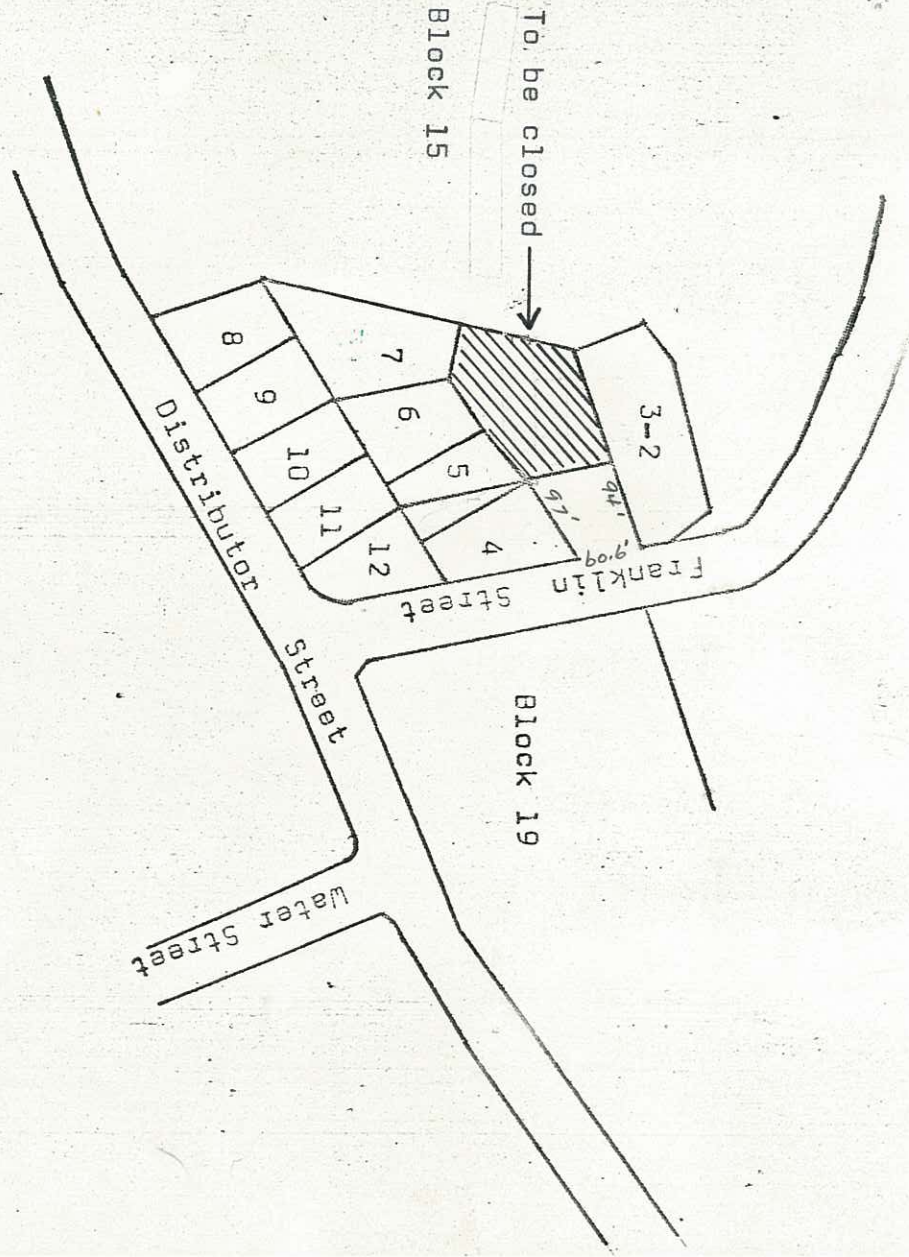
