BY-LAW NO. 2754-25

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW #2711/L+P/23 (BUSINESS LICENCE BY-LAW) TO INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR MOBILE FOOD VENDORS

WHEREAS pursuant to the Cities, Towns and Villages Act, S.N.W.T. 2003, c.22, as amended, the Council of the Town of Inuvik may enact by-laws for the licensing, regulating, and controlling of businesses within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council wishes to support a vibrant mobile food vendor industry while ensuring public safety, cleanliness, and fair competition;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Inuvik, in regular session duly assembled, hereby enacts the following amendments to By-law #2711/L+P/23:

1. DEFINITIONS

Add the following definition to Section 2.0 – INTERPRETATION:

“Mobile Food Vendor (MFV)” means a motor vehicle, trailer, cart, or kiosk equipped for the preparation and sale of food or beverages to the public, whether on public or private land.

Amend the definition of “Hawker/Peddler” by adding the following sentence:

“Mobile Food Vendors are a distinct sub-category of hawkers/peddlers and are subject to additional non-fee-based requirements outlined in the Mobile Food Vendor Policy FP.011.”

2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Add the following subsection to Section 4.0 – GENERAL PROVISIONS:

“4.X Mobile Food Vendors must obtain a standard business licence under this by-law. No additional fee is required; however, they must comply with all applicable requirements outlined in the Mobile Food Vendor Policy FP.011.”

3. LICENCE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Add the following subsection to Section 5.0 – LICENCE APPLICATIONS:

“5.X In addition to standard application materials, applicants intending to operate as Mobile Food Vendors must submit the supporting documents and information required by the Mobile Food Vendor Policy FP.011.”

4. ENFORCEMENT AND REVOCATION

Add the following clause to Section 6.0 – REVOCATION, SUSPENSION, AND CANCELLATION:

“6.X The Senior Administrative Officer may refuse, suspend, or revoke a business licence for a Mobile Food Vendor where the vendor is found to be in violation of the Mobile Food Vendor Policy FP.011.”

5. FINES

Add the following items to SCHEDULE A – FINES:

OFFENCE	AMOUNT
Operating a Mobile Food Vendor contrary to the Mobile Food Vendor Policy	\$250
Operating in a non-approved location or without DVZ or landowner consent	\$250
Failure to comply with sanitation, fire safety, or noise standards	\$250
Operating outside of permitted hours	\$100

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 13 DAY OF AUGUST, 2025.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 13 DAY OF AUGUST, 2025.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 10 DAY OF SEPTEMBER , 2025.




